We will do this by:

- helping pupils to develop their working memory and long-term memory so they improve fluency and remember more
- developing the enrichment offer beyond taught academic lessons.
- working with our community to help bring our curriculum to life.
- 3. We will ensure all children receive additional phonics and reading opportunities to improve children's love for reading.

We will do this by:

- ensuring phonics and reading is led well across the school supported by the English Hub
- ensuring children reading below age expectation receive daily intervention
- reading will be at the heart of our curriculum, raising the profile of reading

2. We will continue to improve the quality of teaching and learning.

We will do this by:

- developing staff, supported by Rosenshine Principles
- ensuring progress of all children accelerate in line with national or better
- developing middle leaders/subject leaders to ensure all subjects are taught effectively
- working collaboratively with subject leaders across the Trust to share best practice
 - 4. We will improve the quality of leadership and management.

We will do this by:

- ensuring consistency across the school in the absence of the headteacher
- ensuring measurable success is assessed regularly and shared with stakeholders
- ensuring high expectations are maintained across all aspects of school
- delivering high quality training to all staff
- ensuring staff feel valued and an integral part of our team
- 5. We will continue to develop our Behaviour Culture to maximise all learning opportunities strengthening our culture of respect and care.

We will do this by:

- ensuring consistent delivery of the Behaviour Policy across school
- continuing to support the mental health of our children to help remove behaviours which may impact negatively on children's progress
- celebrating those who consistently follow our Behaviour Policy

6. We will continue to strengthen links with parents and carers.

We will do this by:

- continuing Parent Forums to ensure parents have full involvement in the vision of the school.
- offering more opportunities for parents to be involved with learning in school
- working collaboratively with FOAKS to raise money to improve outcomes for children.
- maintaining excellent communication with all stakeholders.
