

Foundation Topic Ideas for Week 12

Weather Chart – Back in the winter we looked at the weather each day and kept a weather chart. We would like you to keep one again this week and talk with your child about how each day is different or the same. In the winter we had lots of cloud and rain! Talk with your child and see if they can tell you how it is different in the summer compared to the winter.



Summer Pictures – Each season we have painted tree pictures, showing the changes through the seasons. As we are now in summer we would like the children to paint a summer tree. Talk with your child about how the trees now have lots of leaves and they are all green. Remind them that the green leaves even cover the brown branches! You could also watch the new seasons song that we

had a quick look at school before we closed.

Clothing for Summer – Talk to your children about what they wear when it's summer! Take a look at the pictures of clothes and talk ask your children about each one and whether they would wear it in summer or not. When they have done this ask them to dress a person for summer and a person for winter. This task is good for practising their cutting skills!

Signs of Summer – Keep an eye out this week for the signs of summer. Have a look at the Woodlands Trust website for more information about what you are to look for. Ask your children to keep a note of everything they have noticed and maybe they could make a poster at the end of the week showing all their signs of summer.
