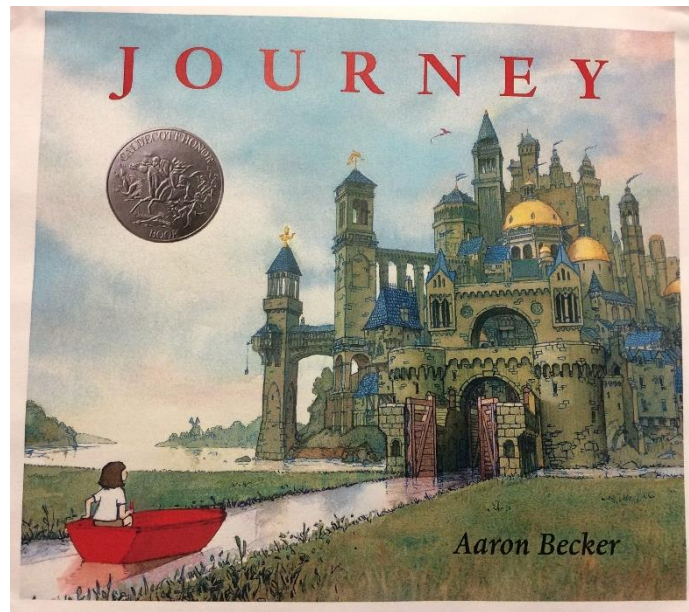
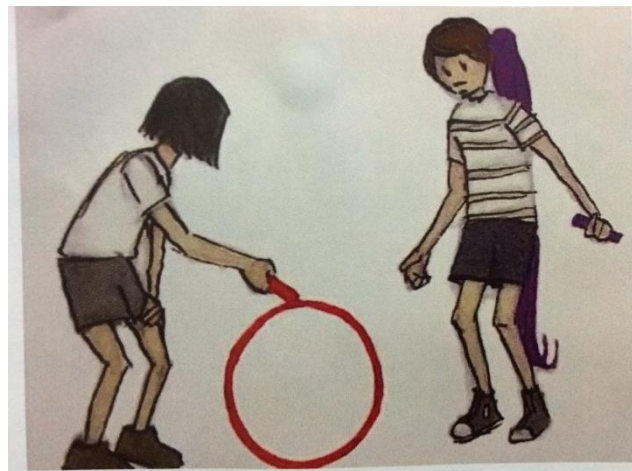


## Class 2 Spring Term 1

This term Class 2 explored the topic of ‘A Picture Paints a Thousands Words’ and have been busy thinking about our big question ‘Where will the crayon take us?’



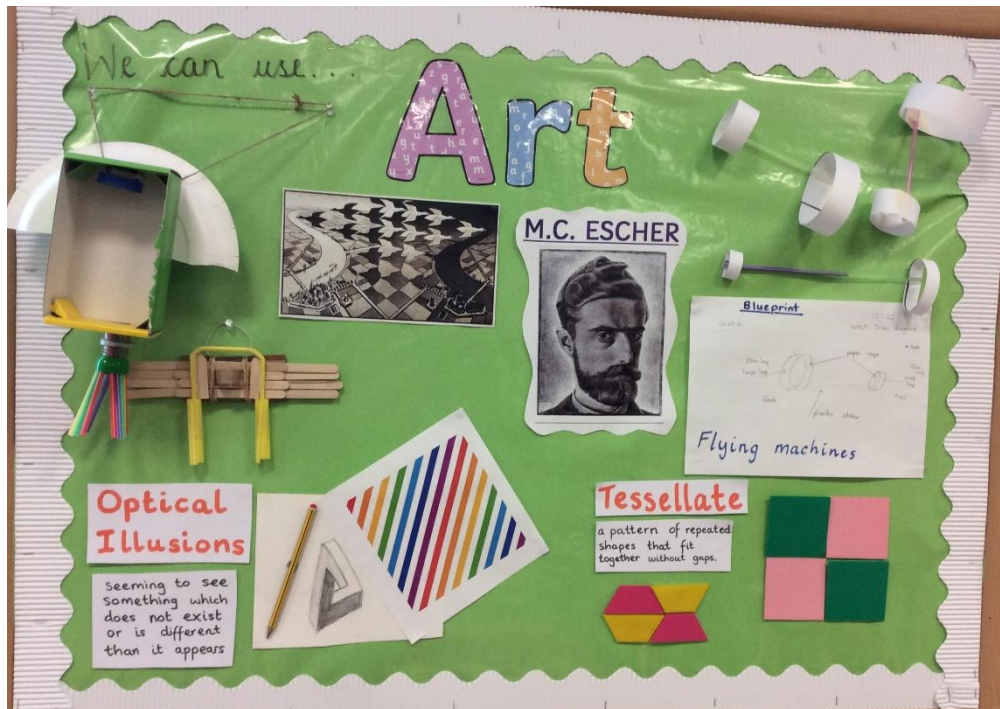
