Rainbow road.


Shared reading.

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Feedback from Parents: What is Working Well?


I enjoy getting updates on class dojo.

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Feedback from Parents: What could we improve?

- Lots of events/meetings etc are within working hours, sometimes it's difficult to get time off work. There have been a lot quite close together recently.
- SEN information and updates on what is being done for my child.
- I have had no updates what is being done for my child to cater for his needs.
- Unfortunately for SEN children the school has poor communication with parents and always has since my son started school.




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Feedback from Parents: Improve?

Maybe reminders/encouragement for bringing home reading books each evening. This reading seems to have less emphasis placed on this year?

More pro active discussions when a child is struggling with a particular subject/topic

Maybe even more encouragement and motivation for children when they do well



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Feedback from Parents: Improve?

Even more music, singing etc? The children have responded so positively to the opportunities they've had so far. Ideally not just as optional after school as these aren't always possible for children to attend in terms of logistics.

Timetabled curriculum music of at least one hour each week
key stages 1-3.

Access to lessons across a range of instruments, and voice.

A school choir and/or vocal ensemble.

A school ensemble/band/group.

Space for rehearsals and individual practice.

A termly school performance.


Opportunity to enjoy live performance at least once a year.
