Monday

Today can you read through the poems about seeds and flowers. Once you have done this can you find all the rhyming words and highlight them, or make a list. After that can you think of at least two more words that will rhyme with the ones you found i.e. sow, grow, blow, Joe! These rhyming words don't have to be ones that are about seeds or flowers, they could just be funny rhyming words!

Tuesday

Today can you choose your favourite poem and re-read it. You can now either write it out yourself, or print it and illustrate it. Can you think of the best drawings that go with the words that you have read. Keep reading it through to make sure you are illustrating it carefully. (Reading it lots of times will also help with tomorrow's task!)

Wednesday

Today is a big day! We would like you to perform your poem! Can you re-read it, as many times as you need to, to be able to say it out loud to an audience! (You can even record it and add it to our school or Facebook pages if you like!)

Thursday

Today and tomorrow you are going to become a poet! Read through the two poems about Spring for inspiration. Can you now make a mind map of how many things you can think of that happen at springtime. These might be things you see, hear, touch, taste or smell. For each of the things you think about can you add an adjective! (Just like we do at school sometimes)



Friday

Can you use your ideas from yesterday to change one of the poems into your own? You can either start each line with 'I love...', where the poem doesn't have to rhyme, or you could be really creative and try to make a rhyming poem about spring. Don't forget to illustrate it. Good luck!
