



## AB KETTLEBY SCHOOL

### Sports Premium Grant Documentation: *Information statement*

In April 2013 the Government announced that it would be providing additional funding to improve the provision of PE and Sport in primary schools. This funding will be available to schools in the future academic years until 2020. From the academic year 2017/18 this grant will be increased by support from the Government's Sugar Tax.

This initiative has been devised to improve the quality and breadth of PE and Sport provision, including increasing participation in PE and Sport across primary schools. Ideally, this will in turn promote healthy lifestyle choices and give children the opportunities to reach the performance levels they are capable of.

At Ab Kettleby School we will be allocating the funding in the following ways;

- Employing qualified coaches to work alongside teachers in lessons to increase their subject knowledge and confidence in sport specific PE.
- Buying into the School Sports Partnership (Melton and Belvoir) to increase pupil participation in local and national school games competitions
- Signing up to the School Games website and aiming for a medal
- Establishing local links with the Vale Sports Partnership for competitive sports amongst other small school teams at Level 1.
- Enhancement of extra-curricular clubs with the emphasis on encouraging our less active children to participate.
- Development of staff to become more confident in delivering PE
- Early establishment of multiskills in KS1, to ensure skills progression and production of a more effective and competitive squad.
- Recognising and supporting children who are Able, Gifted and Talented in PE and sports
- Displaying our sporting achievements and results through our display board and social media
- Ensuring each Class attend at least one event run by the Sports Partnership.

We have worked hard to develop these initiatives; and will continue to build on our already established and successful sporting projects.

A summary of how our funds were spent during the last academic year is as follows:

***Total Grant awarded to Ab Kettleby School £8,260 from September 2016 to September 2017***

*The School was proudly awarded the Gold Mark of the Schools Games, participation was monitored, and pupils encouraged to take part in events or try new skills. The Social Media coverage of sporting events gave the school a raised profile.*
