

Year 1 Maths, Week 7

Our maths learning this week is going to be based on the White Rose Home Learning. This is a brilliant resource that has a clear video with examples, and then questions linked to the video. You may have to pause a few times to answer the relevant question. Please note that you must now download the worksheets via the Ab K website, they are no longer available next to the video. Start by going to <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/> .

We are going to work on **Summer Term – Week 4**.

Day 1 – Add by making 10. We have spent a lot of time on this, but it is a tricky concept. I have included some blank ten frames to help with this.

Day 2 – Subtract within 20. This activity may benefit from practical objects, but try to encourage them to do it without if they can. You could use the practical representation alongside the numbers shown in the video, or use the ten frames from yesterday again.

Day 3 – Add and Subtract word problems. The children may need some help to read the questions, and may need support to understand what is being asked. The maths element should not be too difficult. If they're struggling, use practical objects.

Day 4 – Compare number sentences. Find out your Blockzillas from a few weeks ago! Focus on finding out the answer to each number sentence first, and then compare the numbers. If this is a challenge, break it down to solve one number sentence, then another number sentence. Then ask them to compare the 2 numbers away from the number sentence.

Day 5 – Friday maths challenge! The most suitable questions for Year 1 are questions 1 & 2.

I have added activities to Education City that link with this week's learning. This is not compulsory but a great little add on.
