

## Foundation Topic Ideas for Week 7

Collage – Can you find different magazines or food wrappers to cut out and stick onto the picture of a person to make a new outfit! If you could design your own outfit what would it look like? Would you like a tiger t-shirt, or bright green spotty trousers? If you can't find all the right pieces to cut and stick maybe you could just colour an outfit instead!

Obstacle Course – Can you make an obstacle course around your house or garden? You could throw balled up socks into a washing basket, or jump over cushions, or crawl under a table or chair, climb over a garden chair, or kick a ball into a goal! See how many family members you can get to have a go and see who is quickest!

Favourite Things – Ask the people in your house what their favourite colour, food, place, animal and activity is. Once you have done this you could talk about if anyone has the same favourites, or how we are all different in our choices. Then get each member to make a poster showing their favourite things. Maybe you could add a picture of yourself in the middle!



Minibeast Hunt – Watch this clip about minibeasts and then go and see if you can find any in your garden, or at the park! When you have found as many as you can, chat with your adult about which ones you found the most of. May be you could draw or paint your favourite minibeast. There is also a minibeast game that you might want to try out too!
