

## English for Week 9 Foundation

### Monday

This week we are going to be finishing a story. Today all you need to do is ask your adult to help you read the story so far (the words in red are ones that the children should be able to read!). Once you have done this can you draw a picture of what Harry and Ruffles look like and write a label describing them underneath.

### Tuesday

Today you need to think about where Ruffles was lost! Can you draw a picture of him and write a word to say how he's feeling.

### Wednesday

Now that we know where he was left we need to find out how he was found and by whom! Can you decide if Harry came back for him, or if he was found by someone else. Draw a picture to show what happened next.

### Thursday

Now we need to know what happened to Ruffles and Harry at the end of your story. If Harry found him yesterday what did he do with him next? If someone else found him, did he get back to Harry or not?! If he didn't what happened to him? If he did how did Harry say thank you for getting him back? Can you draw a picture to say what happened.

### Friday

Now you have all your ideas you are ready to write or tell your story. Can you continue the story from where it left off describing the adventures of Harry and Ruffles using all your ideas from the rest of the week. You can do this by drawing a story board of everything that happened, or by writing your story, or by telling it to a grown up. You could even film it and add it to Tapestry for us to see!
