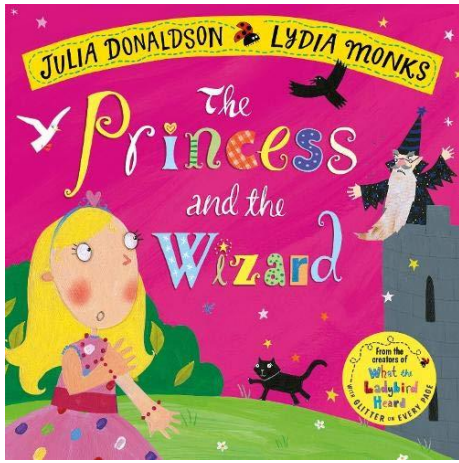


EYFS Maths, Week 9

Our maths learning this week is going to be based on the White Rose Home Learning. This is a brilliant resource that has a clear video which talks you through the activities. The video also has added extras (the days of the week song on Monday), so it's worth giving it a go! You may have to pause a few times to try the relevant activity. Start by going to

We are going to work on **Summer Term – Week 7**. This week's activities are based on 'The Princess & The Wizard' by Julia Donaldson. All of the activities can be done without the book, but it's a great addition. You could also find it read online at

Day 1 – Days of the Week. Lots of lovely ideas to do with matching the Princess's activities to the days of the week, and even coming up with your own outfits for the Princess, the Wizard, or even yourself!

Day 2 – A challenge a day. Can you come up with a challenge for each day of the week? Another great idea is to create your very own number book for the wizard (a great example of this that you may have at home is The Very Hungry Caterpillar – he counts up to 5 with the days Monday to Friday). Could you count up to 7, for each day of the week?

Day 3 – Hide and Wizard! Can you play hide & seek like the wizard? Remember your wizard laugh! What's the spell Mr Wizard? Some great games today.

Day 4 – Make your own potion to keep the wizard away! You must have twenty things in your potion or it won't work, but you can have more than one thing. Will you draw or write your potion? The second activity is doubling and halving, which we have only touched on at school, so don't worry if they find it difficult! Just try your best.

Day 5 – Castle Chase. Use your positional language to talk about who is closer to us. How can you tell? Then, have a go at making the princesses crown symmetrical (the same on both sides).
